

SAFETY RULES FOR VISITORS TO SITE

On this site the safety of
personnel is paramount

You are requested to read and
comply with the following rules.

BE AWARE

- When you arrive on site please park in the designated area and use the yellow pedestrian walkway
- If you walk anywhere on the site other than the pedestrian walkway you must wear high visibility clothes
- Activities on site have mixed hazards and you may be required to wear additional PPE
- Maximum speed of 5mph for all vehicles. Please follow one-way system and beware other vehicle and pedestrian movements
- Please be aware that in addition to LGV vehicles, large container lifting vehicles and construction trucks move through the site

- Some activities are restricted or require a work permit. Please ensure you fully inform us of the work you will perform or actions you wish to take so that we can ensure the safety of you and all other users on site
- If you hear the fire alarm please proceed to the outside of the gates
- If a member of staff in an orange hi-vis issues instructions regarding your movements on site please follow them
- Report any accident that you are involved in to the Site Manager or Supervisor immediately

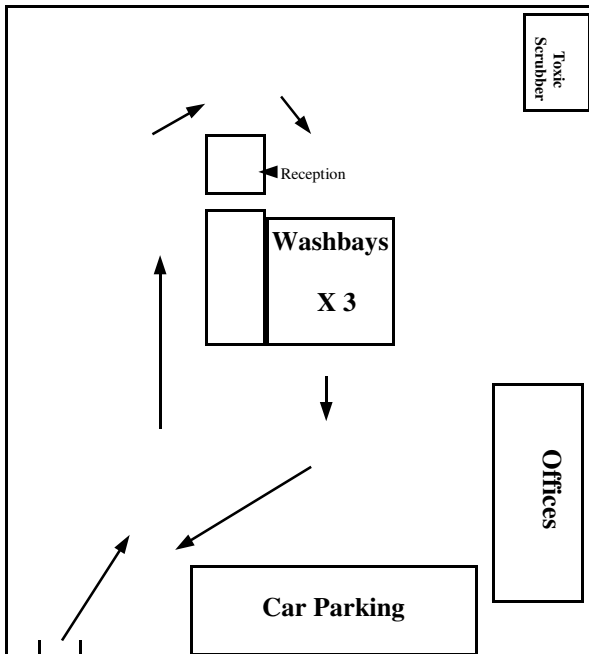
DO NOT

- Enter any area, operate or adjust any machine or safety device or use any portable access equipment except with our consent
- Open manlids/valves before entering cleaning bays
- Undertake any activities which may compromise the safety of you or others
- Use depot equipment unless authorised by Isotank staff
- Climb onto the top of a tank without using a handrail or fall arrest device
- Remove fittings or hoses – unless authorised by Isotank staff
- Carryout authorised tasks unless wearing the appropriate PPE
- Walk around the wash-bay or other working areas
- Smoke – unless in a designated area

Contractors on Site

Please note that you must report to reception prior to accessing the site

A Permit-to-Work system is in place and you will be expected to provide all necessary information before you start work



EMERGENCY PROCEDURES On Hearing the Fire Alarm (Continuous Siren Or Fog Horn)

- Go immediately to the assembly point shown on the Fire Plan and make your presence known to the Fire Marshall

- Do not leave the assembly point until told to do so

IN ALL EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

- Use the nearest available exit
- Do not re-enter the buildings or leave site
- Do not take risks
- Do not stop to collect personal belongings
- Do as instructed by ISOTANK and DENNIS DIXON's personnel
- If you are in a vehicle when the alarm sounds – turn off the ignition and apply the hand brake before making your way on foot to the assembly point
- Leave the keys in the vehicle to enable emergency services to move it, if necessary
